Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited Coaching Re-Accreditation Guidelines

Dear Coach,

Once again it has come time to carry out your re-accreditation with the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme. Please remember that to be accredited you must also be registered with your sport in this case Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited, both go hand in hand together. The fee that Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited has set not only covers you for your registration and Public Liability Insurance but also your accreditation fee with the NCAS this is something you must remember.

If your accreditation has expired and you are a registered coach with Tenpin Bowling Australia in good standing and you wish to re-accredit there are a few obligations or criteria that must be met depending on your Accreditation Level.

Level One:

To stay current as a Level One Coach you must supply a copy of signed evidence of the following for the past 2 years is required.

1. 100hrs of Active Coaching.
 2. Run a Bowlers Proficiency Course
- AND
3. Attend a TBA Ltd Update
- OR
4. Attend a Department of Sports & Recreation course for coaches in your area.
 5. Update to a Level 2 coach at anytime.

Level Two:

To stay as current as a Level Two Coach you must supply a copy of signed evidence of the following for the past 2 years is required.

1. 150 hours of active coaching.
- OR
2. Mentoring of at least one Level One Coach.
- AND
3. Attend a TBA update course
 4. Assist in a State Development Camp or State Team.

Personal Development:

Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited will recognise certain personal development courses as part of your ongoing commitment, an example of these are;

- Presenters Course
- Workplace Assessment
- First Aid Course (within the 2 year period)

Coaches not registered with their sport:

Those coaches who have failed to register with Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited for a period exceeding two (2) years but who still wish to maintain their accreditation must re-apply with TBA Ltd. A Form can be downloaded from www.tenpin.org.au or By writing to the TBA Coaching Registrar.

Please note:

Along with the above documentation you must also include the following documents filled in completely, in legible hand writing.

- Coaches Code of Ethics.
- Child Protection Declaration.
- Registration Form.

Accreditation Period:

The NCAS accreditation period with the NCAS and Tenpin Bowling Australia Limited has been set at Two (2) years.
