# 2010 South Australian State Championships

## Rules and Regulations

1. This event is open to all 2010 TBA registered players and is an accredited TBA Tournament therefore all TBA rules and regulations apply.
2. This is a scratch event with two divisions, Junior or Adult, and bowlers will be placed in grades based on the highest league average from any registered centre as at 31 December 2009.
3. Bowlers who are under the age of 18 years at 1 January 2010 are eligible to compete in the Junior division, those bowlers who have reached the age of 18 years at 1 January 2010 will only be permitted to bowl in the Adult division.
4. Bowlers will be able to participate in singles, doubles and four-person team events in which each entrant will bowl three (3) games per event.
5. Current TBA player registration cards must be produced at check-in for the first event, failure to do so may result in disqualification from all events.
6. **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Entries post dated / stamped no later than Wednesday 3rd February 2010 will be accepted.** All entries must be fully completed in **BLOCK LETTERS**, and must be accompanied by the **FULL ENTRY FEES, part paid entries will not be accepted, this includes Doubles and Team entries.**
7. Additional entries, including masters qualifying attempts, will be accepted on the day of competition from bowlers who have registered prior to the closing date. No refunds will be made after Entry Forms and Fees have been received, if a bowler does not wish to bowl a nominated squad it is their individual responsibility to sell this squad and collect the money for it.
8. **ENTERING AVERAGE AND CUT-OFF DATE:** Players entering this Tournament shall nominate their highest average, established in excess of 18 games in a League or accredited Tournament played to a regular weekly or monthly schedule, as at 31st December 2009. **Providing a false average will lead to automatic disqualification.**
9. **Bowlers not having an established average may apply to the Tournament Director for grading; otherwise an average of 185 for Women and 195 for Men, 185 for Junior Boys and 175 for Junior Girls will be used.** The Tournament Director shall use his/her own discretion to review the entering average submitted for competitors in these Championships, and may re-grade or re-classify any entry at any time.
10. **PRIZE FUND:** All monies subscribed, as Prize Fund shall be returned 100% on the basis of one prize for every five (5) entries to a maximum of 3rd place. All Events prize fund shall be returned on the basis of one prize for every five (5) entries to a maximum of 3rd place.
11. **REPLACEMENTS:** All replacements or changes in the original schedule must be reported to the Tournament Secretary no later than 45 minutes prior to Squad Time. Even if the replacement bowler has an average less than the bowler that was to bowl and this effects the grade this team would have bowled in, the grade shall stand as that entered. If however, the average of the replacement bowler puts the team in a higher grade they will be re-graded to the higher grade.
12. **CHECK-IN TIME:** Players are required to check in no later than 20 minutes before the time of their scheduled squad. Bowlers who are requesting masters attempts must complete the appropriate masters entry form to be handed in at time of check-in for the squad along with payment. Any Masters qualifying will not be accepted after the commencement of practice of that squad.
13. **ALL EVENTS:** Entries for "ALL EVENTS" must be made on the Entry Form showing the selected Grade. An All Events Champion shall be declared for each Grade. A bowler's best appearance in Teams, Doubles and Singles shall count towards their All Events score, regardless of the Grade in which they are bowled. Only ONE paid All Events entry will be accepted from each competitor. No bowler will be listed more than once in the standings. Players who have not paid an all events entry will not be listed in the results.
14. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION:** Unlimited entries may be submitted in each Event and Grade, except for All Events.
15. Smoking is prohibited during continuous play.
16. The consumption and presence of alcohol in a competitors blood stream during competition is prohibited by the TBA Anti-Doping Policy and this policy will be upheld for the duration of the Championships.
17. Participation in this Tournament shall be taken as acceptance of the noted Rules and Regulations; **Therefore no subsequent claims of ignorance will be accepted.**
18. Bowlers must wear neat bowling attire. Shirts without a collar, singlets, stubbies, football style shorts, trackpants and jeans will be not accepted. Acceptable dress code will be determined by the tournament

director.

19. Protests and complaints must be made known verbally to the Tournament Committee within 30 minutes of the alleged infringement. A formal written protest or complaint must then be provided to the Tournament Committee within 48 hours of the offence.
20. Matters not covered in these Rules or the TBA Playing Rules, will be decided on by the tournament committee and their decision shall be final.

### Junior Bumper Challenge:

1. This event is open to all TBA registered bowlers under 10 years of age at 1 January 2010.
2. This is a handicap event with handicaps being allocated against a bowler's entering average based on 100% of 150.
3. Bowlers will not be permitted to use ramps or be assisted with delivery of the ball, only the aid of the bumpers will be accepted.
4. All participants will bowl 2 games in the 10:30am squad on Sunday 14 February 2010.
5. A fee of \$15 is to be paid by all participants.
6. All participants will receive a participation certificate with 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placings receiving medallions.
7. Presentation of the medallions will succeed this 10:30am squad and will be made before the 12pm squad commences bowling.

### Junior Restricted Masters:

1. This event is open to all TBA registered bowlers under the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010 whose entering average (31 December 2009 average) does not exceed 155 for male entrants, and 145 for female entrants who have completed an 'All Events' entry in the State Championships.
2. This is a handicap event with two divisions, one male and one female, with handicaps being allocated on entering averages based on 80% of 200.
3. Qualifying will take place in singles and doubles events of the State Championships. Bowlers wishing to qualify for the Restricted Masters in a squad must pay a \$10 Restricted Masters Qualifying fee before the commencement of that squad. The three game series scored for the doubles or singles event will count as the qualifying score. Qualifying attempts are unlimited
4. The Restricted Masters Final will be contested by the Top 10 Qualifiers in each division. The total number of finalists will be 10 males and 10 females.
5. Bowlers will contest six (6) games with a lane change after each two (2) game block.
6. The bowler in each division with the highest pinfall including handicap after six (6) games will be declared the 2010 SA JUNIOR RESTRICTED MASTERS CHAMPION.

7. If a tie occurs for first, second or third place, a tenth frame roll-off will be conducted to determine the final placing. If a tie still exists, additional tenth frame roll-offs will occur until a winner emerges.
8. A Fee of \$40.00 is to be paid by **ALL** finalists in both male and female divisions.
9. All finalists will be allowed practice on each of the starting two lanes only.
10. Check-in will be 2:00pm sharp, on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2010 for both males and females. Any bowler not checked in by this time will be disqualified and the next available qualifier will replace this position.

### **Restricted Masters:**

1. This event is open to all TBA registered bowlers over the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010 whose entering average (31 December 2009 average) does not exceed 184 for male entrants, and 174 for female entrants.
2. This is a handicap event with two divisions, one male and one female, with handicaps being allocated on entering averages based on 100% of 200.
3. Qualifying will take place in singles and doubles events of the State Championships. Bowlers wishing to qualify for the Restricted Masters in a squad must pay a \$10 Restricted Masters Qualifying fee before the commencement of that squad. The three game series scored for the doubles or singles event will count as the qualifying score. Qualifying attempts are unlimited
4. The Restricted Masters Final will be contested by the Top 10 Qualifiers in each division. The total number of finalists will be 10 males and 10 females.
5. Bowlers will contest six (6) games with a lane change after each two (2) game block.
6. The bowler in each division with the highest pinfall including handicap after the six (6) games will be declared the 2010 SA RESTRICTED MASTERS CHAMPION and must represent South Australia in the National Restricted Cup to be held at Rooty Hill in October 2010 or forfeit that part of the Prize.
7. Note: Champions are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses and arrangements as well as bearing the financial responsibility for bowling an 'All Events' entry, and Restricted Cup qualifying fee in the National Championships to be eligible to participate in the National Restricted Cup.
8. If a tie occurs for first, second or third place, a tenth frame roll-off will be conducted to determine the final placing. If a tie still exists, additional tenth frame roll-offs will occur until a winner emerges.
9. A Fee of \$40.00 is to be paid by **ALL** finalists in both male and female divisions.
10. All finalists will be allowed practice on each of the starting two lanes only.
11. Check-in will be 2:00pm sharp, on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2010 for both males and females. Any bowler not checked in by this time will be disqualified and the next available qualifier will replace this position.

### **Junior Open Masters:**

1. This event is open to all TBA registered bowlers under the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010 who have completed an 'All Events' entry in the State Championships.
2. This is a scratch event with two divisions, one male and one female division.
3. Qualifying will take place in singles and doubles events of the State Championships. Bowlers wishing to qualify for the masters in a squad must pay a \$10 Masters Qualifying fee before the commencement of that squad. The highest three game series scored for a doubles or singles event will count as the qualifying score. Qualifying attempts are unlimited.
4. Twelve (12) bowlers will contest the final stage in both divisions. Bowlers will be seeded from 1-12 by their qualifying scores.
5. A fee of \$60.00 is to be paid by **ALL** Finalists in both divisions. (Excluding Defending Champions)
6. **Final:** All qualifying finalists will compete in a 12-person championship single elimination format with the first four seeded qualifiers in each division getting a bye through to Round 2. Each match will be the best of 3 games. In the case of ties for qualifying positions, the highest last game played in the qualifying series will determine precedence.
7. One player from each division will be assigned to each lane in the first round of play. If a player fails to check-in for the Finals, the highest available non-qualifier will be invited to replace the absent player.
8. After the first match, no further replacements will be permitted. Non-appearance will result in forfeiture of the match with the player present bowling without opposition and advancing to the next round.
9. All players will be given practice on the pair of lanes assigned for their single elimination match.
10. The winner of Round 4 will be declared the SA JUNIOR OPEN MASTERS CHAMPION for 2010 and must represent the State of South Australia at the 2010 Australian Junior Masters in Werribee, Victoria or forfeit that part of the Prize.

11. Note: Champions are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses and arrangements as well as bearing the financial responsibility for bowling an 'All Events' entry, and masters qualifying fee in the Junior National Championships to be eligible to participate in the Junior National Masters.
12. Check-in will be 8.45am sharp, on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2010 for both males and females.

### **Open Masters:**

1. This event is open to all TBA registered bowlers over the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010 who have completed an 'All Events' entry in the State Championships.
2. This is a scratch event with two divisions, one male and one female division.
3. Qualifying will take place in singles and doubles events of the State Championships. Bowlers wishing to qualify for the masters in a squad must pay a \$10 Masters Qualifying fee before the commencement of that squad. The three game series scored for the doubles or singles event will count as the qualifying score. Qualifying attempts are unlimited.
4. Twelve (12) bowlers will contest the final stage in both divisions. Bowlers will be seeded from 1-12 by their qualifying scores.
5. A fee of \$60.00 is to be paid by **ALL** Finalists in both divisions. (Excluding Defending Champions)
6. **Final:** All qualifying finalists will compete in a 12-person championship single elimination format with the first four seeded qualifiers in each division getting a bye through to Round 2. Each match will be the best of 3 games. In the case of ties for qualifying positions, the highest last game played in the qualifying series will determine precedence.
7. One player from each division will be assigned to each lane in the first round of play. If a player fails to check-in for the Finals, the highest available non-qualifier will be invited to replace the absent player.
8. After the first match, no further replacements will be permitted. Non-appearance will result in forfeiture of the match with the player present bowling without opposition and advancing to the next round.
9. All players will be given practice on the pair of lanes assigned for their single elimination match.
10. The winner of Round 4 will be declared the SA OPEN MASTERS CHAMPION for 2010 and must represent the State of South Australia at the 2010 Australian Masters in Rooty Hill, New South Wales or forfeit that part of the Prize.
11. Note: Champions are responsible for their own travel and accommodation expenses and arrangements as well as bearing the financial responsibility for bowling an all-events entry, and masters qualifying fee in the National Championships to be eligible to participate in the National Australian Masters.
12. Check-in will be 1.30pm sharp, on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2008 for both males and females.
13. Please see the attached US Open Lane Condition which will be laid for this event.

### **Association Cup**

1. Each Association is invited to enter a team consisting of four (4) male and four (4) female bowlers who have reached the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010 and four (4) male and four (4) female bowlers who are under the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010.
2. This will be a handicap event and handicaps will be allocated according to entering averages (31 December 2009 averages) based on 80% of 200.
3. Associations Cup Teams will bowl compete in:
  - One (1) Male Teams Event
  - One (1) Female Teams Event
  - One (1) Junior Male Teams Event
  - One (1) Junior Female Teams Event
  - Two (2) Male Doubles Events
  - Two (2) Female Doubles Events
  - Two (2) Junior Male Doubles Events
  - Two (2) Junior Female Doubles Events
  - Four (4) Male Singles Events
  - Four (4) Female Singles Events
  - Four (4) Junior Male Singles Events
  - Four (4) Junior Female Singles Events
2. All bowlers must bowl:
  - One (1) Teams Event
  - One (1) Doubles Event
  - One (1) Singles Event

And therefore a bowler cannot bowl more than one Singles, Doubles or Team event that will count towards the Association Cup.

3. Events counting towards the Association Cup can be bowled at any time during the State Championships Squads but the Tournament Officials must be notified prior to the commencement of the squad. Notification by the Tournament Team will be given on the scoresheet and if this does not appear, please contact tournament officials.
4. Total cost per Association will be \$150.(This does not include the entry or registration costs of each bowler)

### **Tenpin SA Pro-Am Doubles**

1. This event is open to all TBA registered bowlers who have paid the 2010 South Australian State Championships nomination fee.
2. This is a TBA accredited tournament and as such all TBA rules and regulations apply.
3. This is a handicapped event with one division.
4. Doubles combinations are to be made up of one player who is under the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010 and one player who reached the age of 18 years as at 1 January 2010.
5. Handicaps will be allocated 80% of 200 based on entering averages.
6. Each participant will bowl three games with their nominated partner in any doubles squad of the state championships.
7. Bowlers wishing to nominate for this event must fill out the appropriate entry form and indicate to the Tournament Team they are nominating for this event before the commencement of practice for that squad.
8. The Doubles line-up must be decided and confirmed at check-in and cannot be changed throughout the 3-game block.
9. Entry fee for the doubles combination will be \$50.
10. The winner of this event will be the doubles combination with the highest pinfall plus handicap.
11. Multiple participation is allowed and bowlers may enter with more than one doubles partner, as long as these represent separate entries.
12. The 2010 South Australian State Championships rules and regulations apply to this tournament, except for where there are inconsistencies and the rules in this section shall apply.
13. Any rules not covered in these rules and regulations, the 2010 South Australian State Championships rules and regulations or TBA Playing Rules are subject to the discretion of the Tournament Team and their decision shall be final.
